

LEVEL 2 Men's Artistic

Developing Performance:

The MAG Level 2 Coach qualification is the second level on the Gymnastics Ireland coaching qualification structure. The holders of this qualification may assume responsibility for an individual, group, class or club when coaching skills within the syllabus.

The Level 2 Coach must demonstrate competence at developing the listed skills and techniques through recommended procedures including: prerequisite skills, physical preparation, safe and effective progressions and supporting techniques and use of training aids where appropriate.

Course Duration:

Day 1 – Generic
Days 2 & 3 – Sports Specific
Day 4 - Sports Specific, in course assessment & course re-cap
Day 5 – Generic
Day 6 – L2 Assessment for both Theory & Practical

Course Pre-Requisites:

Candidates must be over 17 and hold a current Gymnastics Ireland membership. Candidates must also hold any of the following qualifications from these previous or current coaching cycles to attend:

Cycle 1 – Introductory Level MAG or WAG
Cycle 2 – Apprentice Level MAG or WAG
Cycle 2 - Club Coach Level WAG
Cycle 3 (2013 – 2014) – Level 1 MAG or WAG
Cycle 3 (2013 – 2014) – Level 2 WAG

Who is it for?

The course is aimed at coaches working in a gymnastics club, aged 17 or above. It is designed to educate & facilitate coaches to assume responsibility for an individual, group, class or club when coaching skills within the syllabus.

What level are the skills aimed at?

The skills covered are specific to coaching MAG within a club setting (see course syllabus).

Course Certification:

All candidates will receive a Gymnastics Ireland, MAG Level 2 qualification awarded by Coaching Ireland. Coaches are certified to coach within the Level 2 syllabus in a club setting. Candidates may decide to go directly on to a MAG Level 3 course or transfer to another discipline-specific coaching course. (Arrangements will be made by Gymnastics Ireland for members aged between 16 and 18 to complete a Child Protection Awareness/Safeguarding Workshop on receipt of written consent from parent/guardian).

Further Information:

Before enrolling on a coaching course please be aware:

1. The candidate is expected to provide gymnasts for the practical days of the course and the assessment
2. The candidate will be required to find a mentor coach (the mentor should hold a GI coaching award the level above the award being taken and usually in that discipline)
3. All course days require the candidates' attendance, including the assessment date
4. The qualification process, from the start of a course to the assessment, takes approximately 4 months
5. It is the responsibility of the coach attending the course to enrol themselves
6. To enrol on-line a membership number is required and an email confirmation will be sent to you confirming your booking.
